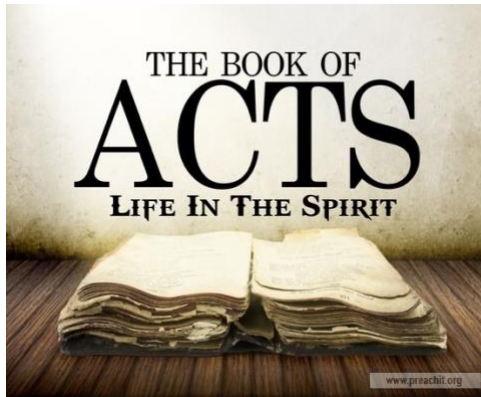

United Mission to Seafarers

Joel Pearce, Mike Houlding, Phil Price, Marcus Wilkins, John Hill, Graeme Steel, Garry Poynton and others from HTT contribute time each week at the Port of Tauranga helping visiting seafarers. Our mission is to help make seafarers feel welcome and valued. In addition to providing seafarers with currency exchange, wifi and transport, we sell a wide range of souvenirs, food and basic groceries.

It would be easy to simply process them through without engaging with them, but we have tried to personalise their visit by donating free knitted beanies and children's wear to them.

We now have over 80 knitters nationwide producing hundreds of items, most knitters having been found via a small article in the NZ Motor Caravan magazine, although a loyal group from Copper Crest, coordinated by Patricia Bourne have contributed many dozens of items.

The ability to give seafarers a free knitted item and the chance to share fellowship with them, makes voluntary work incredibly satisfying for us all. Most of our visitors are from the Philippines, many from China and south Asia and some from Russia. All of them get to experience hospitality and respect and take a tangible reminder to sea - and to their homes - of Kiwi love in action. I attach a photo taken last week of a happy Dad, with his free beanie and a jersey for his 3 year old son.
